

100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Friends of Alva Academy bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils and supporting the running costs of the school minibuses.

RULES

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number to go in the draw.
2. A draw will be made every month with 2 x £50 prizes drawn.
3. The prizes will total £100.
4. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Alva Academy School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
5. Numbers are limited to two per household.
6. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual ParentPay. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
9. The draw shall be made by a committee member of Friends of Alva Academy at the start of each month. The draw will be witnessed by at least one member of the school staff.
10. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the Friends of Alva Academy FaceBook page.
12. The 100 Club will be run by Friends of Alva Academy. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Friends of Alva Academy funds after six months.
